_____ **Shelter Management:** provide service and protection to women and children at the emergency shelter. Attend to immediate needs of new residents, assist residents with daily needs, handle crisis calls, intakes and be available to help in other areas like in the nursery or kitchen.

_____ **Transitional**

In keeping with FVPS's mission of promoting long-term independence and complete self-sufficiency, adults and children continue to receive counseling and case management services while participating in the *Transitional Housing Program*. This program supports the survivor in developing, skills such self-sufficiency, in order to achieve a new beginning for a healthy future.

_____ **Children's Services:** The intern will be asked to assist with services plans, intakes, reports, mentoring, after school programming that may include therapeutic, educational and physical activities and Nursery assistance with 0-4 yrs.

_____ **Violence Intervention Program:** The *Violence Intervention Program (VIP)* is group counseling for male and female perpetrators of domestic abuse and family violence. Battering is a repeated use of control over another person and the BIPP curriculum holds offenders (male and female) accountable for abusive behavior and are taught the fundamentals of a healthy nonviolent relationship. A variety of topics are designed to address different aspects of family violence and abuse.

FVPS's Violence Intervention Program is a fully accredited Battering Intervention and Prevention Program (BIPP), developed by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

_____ **Counseling Services Program:** Counseling Services, with Family Violence Prevention Services, Inc., excels in providing counseling services to adults, children and families. Consider interning by helping our dynamic team of professionals and have the opportunity to serve those in need.

_____ **Celebrating Families:** When children experience homes with chemical dependency, domestic violence, and abuse or neglect, they learn unhealthy ways of living, which often leads to future addiction, abuse, violence, and other problems. Celebrating Families changes lives by teaching parents and children the skills needed to feel, talk, trust, and be healthy. The 16 session curriculum covers a range of topics including communication, anger management, chemical dependency, and healthy boundaries, to name a few. Undergraduate Students facilitate in psycho-educational group settings and also have the opportunity to complete hours in office and participate in outside events.

Participation in the Celebrating Families program is by Child Protective Services (CPS) referral only.

_____ **Community Based Counseling Program at Haven for Hope:** If you have a desire to provide service and outreach to our community, specifically people experiencing homelessness, look no further. Community Based Counseling (CBC), at Haven for Hope, excels in providing counseling services to adults, children and families. Consider helping our dynamic team of professionals where you will have the opportunity to serve those in need. For the chosen candidate CBC pledges to provide you a life changing and transformational experience. CBC has the opportunity to teach a student a skill, but CBC does not have the influence to change a person's character. Therefore we are selective in our interviewing and selection process because excellence of character matters to CBC.
